SUBJECT: U.N. Cyprus Force

The President has decided that the U.S. will provide troop airlift free of cost to the U.N. where countries contributing forces to the U.N. Cyprus Force are unable to furnish their own transportation. The President expects that this particular airlift will be absorbed within the operational airlift capability of the Department of Defense and that no additional funds will be required by the Department.

The President has not approved any financial contribution to the U.N. or general supply of equipment and logistic support. He has instructed that any U.S. decision to supply equipment or support be made only on the basis of clear demonstration that reliance on the U.S. is the only feasible recourse. In the event that the President decides equipment and logistic support should be furnished, financing arrangements will be determined at that time.
