MEMORANDUM FOR MR. BUNDY

The attached draft NSAM would return to the Secretaries of State and Defense the rather extensive operations involved in the evacuation and protection of U.S. citizens in danger areas abroad. The problem was originally brought to the NSC many years ago but has not been monitored by the NSC since 1961.

It is my strong feeling that the Secretaries of State and Defense will feel more responsible for the program if it is taken out of the NSC area. Obviously, major decisions in this area would be referred to the President. The existence of the NSC document has little meaning. The two Departments are agreed on how they will handle this problem and the operations will be carried out on a day-to-day basis by the State-Defense group known as the Washington Liaison Group.

In accordance with discussions between Mr. Bromley K. Smith of your staff and officers of this Department, there is enclosed a draft National Security Action Memorandum on the Evacuation and Protection of U. S. Citizens in Danger Areas Abroad.

The Secretary of Defense has agreed to the text of the draft NSAM.

The Washington Liaison Group, which is the interagency committee concerned with Emergency and Evacuation matters (comprised of State, Defense, Joint Chiefs of Staff, Army, Navy, Air Force) recommends that the NSAM be classified CONFIDENTIAL rather than SECRET as is the existing NSC document.

In accordance with a November 7, 1963 memorandum from Mr. Charles Johnson of your staff, there is enclosed a draft National Security Action Memorandum on the Evacuation and Protection of U. S. Citizens in Danger Areas Abroad.
