MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

I recommend that you approve the Nuclear Propulsion Plant for CVAN 68 as a program of highest national priority which would make it eligible for use of the automatic DX industrial priority rating.

The FY 1967 shipbuilding program includes a nuclear powered aircraft carrier, CVAN 68, which is scheduled for completion in FY 1972. The nuclear propulsion plant is the pacing item and requires a DX priority rating in order to meet the delivery schedule for the carrier. This power plant, unlike the eight reactor plant on the USS Enterprise, is a two reactor system with a thirteen year core life.

Assignment of the DX priority to this program is expected to have little impact on the production schedules of other programs in view of its relatively limited dollar value of \$95 million through FY 1972.

Subject: DX Priority for Nuclear Propulsion Plant for CVAN 68

We have discussed with Defense staff the September 14 memorandum for the President in which the Defense Department asks that he approve the nuclear propulsion plant for CVAN 68 to make it eligible for use of the automatic DX industrial priority rating.

In addition to the reasons given in the memorandum, we find the Defense request to be a modest one; they are not asking for this rating on the whole ship nor on the follow ships. The major industry adversely affected would include agencies, public or private, which have on order central station nuclear power plants, and we feel that while this may be serious it will not be critical.

Accordingly, we would recommend approval of the Defense Department request.
