
Senator & Jim will both probably be here next week -

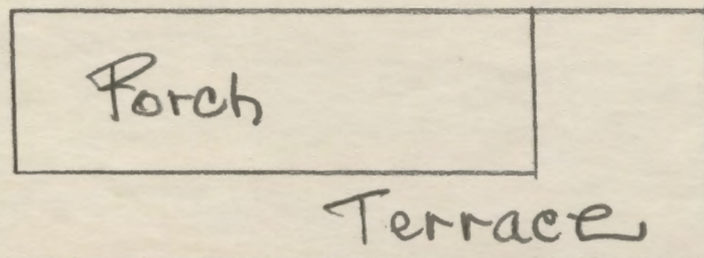

Am enclosing some suggestions re

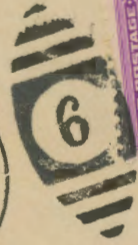
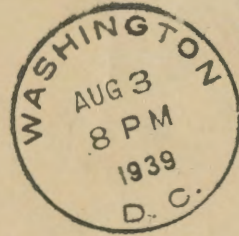


5. Would eliminate lavatory in garage and convert this space into storage space.
