He requested that I come back to see him in two weeks and if I had gained as much as three pounds he would be satisfied. I am almost tempted to go by his office this afternoon and tell him that I have gained five pounds, but will wait until the end of the two weeks and hope to be able to show him that I have gained ten pounds.
