Scope and content note:

This collection consists of materials related to Charles Horsky's work as a Presidential advisor on National Capital Affairs during the Lyndon Baines Johnson administration. The files contain materials related to issues facing the District of Columbia, including home rules, government organization, education, employment, race relations, transportation, health, welfare, housing, food stamps, crime, poverty, substance abuse, landmarks, parks, cultural institutions, youth programs, vocational training, and appropriations. The collection includes articles, photographs, letters, resumes, organizational charts, reports, mailing lists, architectural drawings, plans, financial records, carbon copies, photocopies, annual and serial publications, and feasibility studies. The files also contain petitions signed by District of Columbia residents endorsing individuals for positions on the D.C. Council and related materials.
