#### Scope and content note:

The series consists mostly of correspondence with Lyndon B. Johnson's Texas constituents and covers a wide range of public relations, legislative, political and administrative topics, including office administration; agriculture; armed services, including military installations in Texas; civil rights; commerce, including trade, exports, imports, and transportation; presidential nominations, including those to the judiciary in Texas; education; elections and campaigns; foreign relations; labor; the national budget; natural resources; especially water, gas, and oil; Texas post offices and postmasters; press relations; public works, including dams, reservoirs, parks, and public power; taxes; and welfare.

The series also includes material relating to legislation sponsored by Lyndon B. Johnson, newsletters from Johnson's Senate office, invitations to the Senator, and condolence letters to Johnson following the death of his mother, Rebekah Johnson in 1958. The series includes letters; telegrams; carbon copies of outgoing letters; memorandums; press releases, statements; lists; agendas; itineraries; invoices; clippings, pamphlets, brochures, printed programs and other published material; briefs and reports submitted to Johnson; congressional bills, acts, and committee reports; and a few photographs.

#### Subcategories:

Arranged in three subseries by year, 1958, 1959, and 1960 through January 20, 1961; thereunder, alphabetically by major topics. Subtopics are arranged alphabetically under the major topics and may be further divided into sub-subtopics which are arranged alphabetically or, as in the case of invitations, chronologically by date.

## 1958 "SUBJECT FILES, 1949-1961." 22 ½ feet. Boxes 579-632.

In the 1958 files reorganization, the "Legislative Files," parts of the "General Files" and subjects previously filed in the "Case and Project Files" were consolidated into a classified subject system.

During the 1958 files reorganization many 1958 documents, previously filed in other files, were refilled under the new system and thus contain "Case and Project," "General," or "legislative" files classifications instead of "Subject File" classifications. The "Subject Files" classifications appear in the upper right hand corner of the page. Masters not changed to reflect change.

The files cover a wide range of public relations, legislative, political, and administrative topics and include correspondence; memoranda; press releases and statement; lists; clippings and tear sheets; convention and dinner programs; congressional bills, acts, and committee reports; invoices; resolutions; itineraries; pamphlets, brochures, and other publications; briefs and reports submitted to Senator Johnson; and a few photographs. Some of the records are photocopies.

The folders are arranged alphabetically by subject and most subjects are further broken down into sub-topics arranged under the original subject alphabetically in either sub-topic folders or in 25 alphabetical file folders. Many papers are loose in boxes under their general subject heading; these should be placed in folders and the titles added to the Senate Checklist. Some correspondence, particularly that in the "Public Works" category, has been brought forward from other years.

Twelve boxes of material at the end of the series are unarranged. A few folders of papers in the unarranged material belong in the 1959 and 1960 "Subject Files." Papers in the last box in folders labeled "interfile" range from 1949 through 1961 and should be placed in the appropriate collections.
