Biographical sketch:

Lawrence Francis O'Brien served as the Director of Organization for the Kennedy-Johnson Presidential campaign in 1960, was the Special Assistant to the President for Congressional Relations and Personnel from 1961 to 1965, Postmaster General of the United States from 1965 to 1968, and Chairman of the Democratic National Committee from 1968 to 1972. O'Brien authored *"No Final Victories"* in 1974.

Scope and content note:

This collection consists papers collected by Lawrence O'Brien that document his service as the campaign manager for John F. Kennedy's Senate and Presidential campaigns, Lyndon B. Johnson's campaign for President in 1964, Robert Kennedy's campaign for the Democratic nomination for President in 1968, and Hubert H. Humphrey's campaign for President in 1968. The collection also contains materials related to his service in the Kennedy administration as the Special Assistant to the President for Congressional Relations and Personnel, in the Johnson administration as the Special Assistant to the President for Congressional Relations, his tenure as Postmaster General under President Johnson, his tenure as the Democratic National Committee Chairman in 1968 and 1970, and his work as an author.
