1	9:30a			Drive through downtown Nicosia en route Labor Ministry to Inaugurate 1962 CARE school lunch program. Streets packed with people. VP got out of car several times to greet the people and while going through the Turkish section he stopped to make an impromptu talk from the balcony of Turkish Vice President Kutchuk's private residence.	
2	10:30a			To Labor Ministry to inaugurate 1962 CARE school lunch program. VP introduced by Minister of Labor, Papadopoulos. VP made an informal talk.	
3	11:10a			To Parliament Building to make a formal address before Parliament (the first appearance of a foreign guest before this legislative body.) Speech concluded with presentation of a gavel to House President Clerides. VP then shook hands with each member of Parliament present on the Floor.	
4	11:50a			To Vice President Kutchuk's residence for discussions with Dr. Kutchuk and Cypriot leaders.	
5	12:00n			To Presidential Palace for luncheon hosted by President Makarios. Toast at lunch given.	
6	3:00p			To airport accompanied by Dr. Kutchuk. Make farewell remarks at airport.	
7	3:30p			Depart Cyprus for Greece, via VC 137 travelling 500 nautical miles (575 statute miles) in 1 hour and 30 minutes.	
8	5:30p			Arrived Athens airport and greeted by Prime Minister and Mrs. Caramanlis, American Ambassador and Mrs. Labouisse and other senior Greek and U.S. Officials. Military honors rendered.	
9	5:50p			To Hotel Grande Bretagne, greeting crowds along way, stopping frequently.	
10				To the Royal Palace accompanied by Ambassador and Mrs. Labouisse to sign guest book.	
11				Return to hotel. Private dinner. Massage. Work with Crockett et all. To bed.
