2.	9:30 AM		✓	Call to Walter Jenkins, Washington, D.C. - charged 5121 credit card.	
3.	11:30 AM			Depart LBJ Ranch on LBJ Lodestar for Houston, Texas. Accompanied by George Reedy, Yolanda Boozer, Rufus Youngblood and Jerry Kivett. In flight approx. 1 hour 15 minutes.	
4.	12:45 PM			Arrive Houston International Airport, Executive Aircraft Hanger. V.Pres. met by Mr. and Mrs. Jack Valenti ...taken by them to National Airlines ramp 20 minutes later.	
5.	1:10 PM			Boards National Airlines aircraft (Flight #32) for Miami, Florida, non-stop. Airlines tickets picked up by Secret Servicemen.	
6.	4:30 PM			Vice President and party arrive at Gate #28, Miami Airport. Greeted by official reception committee consisting of Senator Claude Pepper, candidate for Congress and: Dante B. Fascell, Member of Congress, Arthur Courshon, Chairman of Dinner Committee, Jack Gordon, School Board, guest of Courshon; Tom Adams, Sec'y of State; other representatives of the state cabinet and city and county officials. Press and TV cameras follow the Vice Pres. from the moment he deplanes until he is inside the concourse. V.Pres. greets and shakes hands. No speech.	
7.	4:45 PM			Motorcade leaves MIA terminal area...20 cars plus security vehicles at front and rear. Senator and Mrs. Pepper ride with the VPres. Agent Youngblood and the driver, Agent Wells, accompany.	
8.	5:15 PM			Arrive at Colored Section where reception and band, banners, placards, etc. await. Group of about 200 colored people there. Vice Pres. gets out of the car and shakes hands, is presented with yellow rose for coat lapel.	
9.	5:30 PM			Leave Colored area for Torch of Friendship in downtown Miami.

VPres walks to Torch statue with Senator Pepper, is presented with Gold Torch of Friendship cigaret lighter, meets students from Peru there on Operation Amigo program. Is presented lighter by Miami Mayor, Robert King High. Shakes hands, waves to crowds and returns to car. Makes brief address. Recorded.	
11.	6:10 PM			Leaves Torch of Friendship for Hotel.	
12.	6:30 PM			Arrives at Hotel Fontainebleau, north entrance, private elevator. Goes to Suite 17H --- accompanied by Senator and Mrs. Pepper and Agents.	
13.	8:00 PM			Is met by Senator and Mrs. Pepper in suite and goes to East Ballroom in hotel for Banquet. Band plays as VPres. enters Ballroom, Mrs. Marie Balaban sings "Getting to Know You." Presiding is Honorable Fuller Warren, former Governor of Florida. Invocation by Dr. Irving Lehrman. Mrs. Balaban sings "God Bless America." Introduction of the Vice Pres. by Tom Adams, Secretary of State, State of Florida. Address by the Vice President at approx. 9:30 PM
