Building for the football stadium arriving at 3:35 p.m. At 3:50 p.m. he departed the football stadium and arrived at the air strip at 4 p.m. At 4:05 p.m. he was airborne by helicopter to Albuquerque, New Mexico, and arrived Kirkland Air Force Base at 4:45 p.m. At 5:00 p.m. he left Kirkland by Air Force jet star en route to the LBJ Ranch.
