#### **Biographical sketch:**

Robert Coldwell Wood was a management organization expert at the U.S. Bureau of the Budget, Under Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and Secretary of HUD. He also served as a professor of political science at Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Harvard University, University of Massachusetts, and Wesleyan University, and was president of the University of Massachusetts.

#### **Scope and content note:**

This collection consists of materials collected by Robert C. Wood pertaining to his activities as Under Secretary and Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development. In addition, there is also material related to Wood's continued work with urban development, as well as his positions with Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Harvard, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, and the University of Massachusetts.
