Isaac Milton Sacks was an educator and political scientist. He was a research analyst in Southeast Asia and international communism with the U.S. Department of State, and a professor at Yale and Brandeis Universities in the areas of comparative government, international communism, and politics in Vietnam and Southeast Asia.

**Scope and content note:**

This collection contains materials collected by I. Milton Sacks during his tenure as a university student, through his military and government service, and throughout his academic career as a professor specializing in Southeast Asia. This collection reflects Sacks' extensive knowledge of Indochina, especially Vietnam, and includes books, publications, reports, pamphlets, brochures, magazines, clippings, and correspondence.
