Gov. Hughes: I would like to report to you on the current problems we're having.

LBJ: Well I just wanted you to know that the President, the Attorney General and everyone here wants to support you and give you any aid. Jim Jones tells me that you've submitted a report, you've done a good job, I want you to set an example. I'm absolutely positive the people of this country do not want to violate the law

Gov. Hughes: Well, we've had 4 tests already, I just left the conference, one of these on the board is Judge Whipple ...and they've agreed with me to call in the grand jury and indict these violaters...

LBJ: Well you just let Ramsey Clark or Mr. Hoover, we want to make a model out of your city, you make a model of this project that every Gov. of this nation can be proud of and send me a full report.
