B I'm very grateful to you, but I don't think I could consider that at this time. My personal situation is such that I just don't see how I could work it out.

A That's fine. I just wanted to give you that.

B I'm very grateful to you and appreciate it more than you'll ever know. I am just in a situation where I just don't believe I could work it out at this time even if it developed that it were possible for it to materialize.

A I think you know best, and I am in no position to dispute it. I think it could be worked unless Tarborough did something.

B Yes, I don't know what his reaction would be. I know of no particular reason, but have had no personal confrontation.

A We don't have to cross that bridge yet. We might some day, but not now.
