WATSON: This is Marvin Watson.

DALEY: How are you, Marvin?

WATSON: Fine, and I hope you are all right, Sir?

DALEY: Very good!

WATSON: I wanted to report that I understand the meeting was scheduled this morning at 11:00 with Mr. Clifford. However, I read on a tickertape, #AP 43's our number, a report out of the Los Angeles which says "Senator Robert F. Kennedy, Democrat from New York, will announce on Monday his candidacy for the Democratic Presidential nomination, the Herald Examiner said today. The report from the Paper's political editor in Sacramento, Phil Hanna, added that Democrat Jesse M. Unruh, Speaker of the California Assembly, will head a Kennedy Delegation in the State's June fourth Primary^{ly} election. Unruh told a news conference Wednesday, that he had urged Kennedy to become a candidate, but he said nothing about heading a delegation. The Herald Examiner gave no source for its information, saying only it had learned that Kennedy would announce." And that's timed at 11:30 our time, which means this was

actually put out, obviously, prior to the meeting at

11:00. I just thought you'd want to know that.

DALEY: Thank you, Marvin.

WATSON: Thank you, Sir.

DALEY: Very good.
