The Vice President called the President at 12:31p today (Aug 25, 1968) and left this message with mf

1. Tell the President and Lady Bird that the picture on the front page of the Washington Star today was magnificent. I don't know why they didn't run it earlier... why it took them so long to use it.
2. Tell the President that I'm keeping in close touch with Governor Connally and working with him on matters that are of common concern.
3. Tell him I would hope he might tune into the Meet the Press special today at 4:00p with some publishers. I think he would like at least some of it.
4. We're doing well on the platform. I've been keeping a personal watch on it.
5. I'm off to Chicago to that awful orgy called the convention. I went to Connie Freeman's wedding yesterday and suppose that's the last time that I'll hear the word "love" this week.
6. Tell him we liked his speech at San Marcos... it was just great.
7. And tell them both that Muriel wants to be remembered to them... we're grateful to him and to Lady Bird for all their kindnesses.
