One important point, I didn't include. After talking with Bohlen and Thompson, I made a special point of Berlin. I said that referred to the stated interests of the United States.. and I want to underline the seriousness with which we undertake that expression. There is very little serious confusion in that part of the world these days, but we do not trust Ulbricht, and that we want to be sure everyone understands that any move against or ~~interference~~ interference with Berlin would be a matter of the gravest possible concern, and he took the point, and I just wanted to let you know that I specifically mentioned Berlin.
