## PERSONAL PAPERS OF JOSEPH L. BLOCK

**Creator:** Block, Joseph L. (Joseph Leopold), 1902-1992

### Biographical sketch:

Joseph Leopold Block (1902-1992) was an executive with the Inland Steel Company. He was a consultant to the War Production Board from 1941 to 1945. Block also served Presidents John F. Kennedy, Lyndon B. Johnson, and Richard M. Nixon as a member of the President's Advisory Committee on Labor Management Policy.

### Scope and content note:

The collection consists of correspondence, telegrams, minutes of meetings, and printed material pertaining to Joseph Block's service on the President's Advisory Committee on Labor-Management Policy. The records include material related to steel prices, employee benefits, union issues, and tax treatment. An interesting account of a White House dinner (June 22, 1965) is also included.
