**Creator:** Evans, Luther Harris, 1902-

### Biographical sketch:

Luther H. Evans was an American political scientist who served as the tenth Librarian of the United States Congress. From Bastrop County, Texas, he was a renowned story teller who, like his contemporary Lyndon Baines Johnson, used humor to defuse tense political situations in long meetings and build consensus.

### Scope and content note:

This collection consists of a three-page transcript of Luther Evans' recollections of a meeting with President Lyndon B. Johnson and others on the subject of immigration on June 16, 1965. The title is "LBJ Educates the Immigration Reformers."
