TO : The President

DATE: January 13, 1964

FROM : U. S. Secret Service

SUBJECT: Visit to Union Station on January 14, 1964, to welcome His Excellency Antonio Segni.

11:45 a.m. The President and Mrs. Johnson depart the White House.

11:55 a.m. The President and Mrs. Johnson arrive Union Station and are met by Mr. Sam King, Assistant State Department Protocol Officer. The President is then escorted to Track #18, receives his usual honors, and takes his place at the head of the receiving line.

12:00 noon His Excellency Antonio Segni and Mrs. Segni and party arrive at Track #18 and are greeted by the President and the reception committee.

Both Presidents take their places at the reviewing stand for the National Anthems of both nations. The President will offer his welcome speech followed by translation, and the Italian President's response and translation.

The President will then escort the Italian President to the awaiting automobile.

12:25 p.m. Motorcade departs Union Station. Upon departure from Union Station, a 21-gun salute will be fired.

12:30 p.m. Arrival at the intersection of 7th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue. Presidents Johnson and Segni will head a parade of welcome (weather permitting).

12:50 p.m. Presidents Johnson and Segni arrive at the Blair House. The Honorable Walter N. Tobriner will present the key to the city of Washington, D. C., to President Segni.

12:55 p.m. President and Mrs. Johnson will take leave of President and Mrs. Segni and return to the White House.

12:58 p.m. The President and Mrs. Johnson arrive the White House.
