Views General MacArthur's remains placed aboard C-130. C-130 towed from its position and Mrs. MacArthur's plane brought up. Pres. escorts Mrs. MacArthur and Arthur to ramp of their plane and bades them goodbye.
- 2:16 p. m.      To chopper accompanied by General Clifton. Departs MATS.
- 2:18 p. m.      Arrives South grounds White House.
