THE WHITE HOUSE
WASHINGTON

To be added to the Diary for April 11, 1964:

After the President showed the Northeast States Conference Group the Swimming Pool, he took them to the Mansion and started the tour on the third floor. Just as the tour started, Mrs. Johnson walked through and stopped to shake hands with a few of the members of the group. The President then proceeded to take the group through the Yellow Room, The Green Room, the Lincoln Bedroom, Queen's Bedroom and then into his bedroom, pointing items of special interest in each of them. In the President's Bedroom, he pointed out the painting of his birthplace and mentioned that, even though one is born in a small cabin, he can become President in these United States if he is prepared. The President then took the group to the Second Floor where they toured the East Room, the Red, Blue, and Green Rooms, and the State Dining Room. They then descended the stairway and walked thru the Diplomatic Reception Room to the South Portico where each of them shook hands with the President, extended thanks for the tour and left at approximately 2:15 p. m.
