	4:30p			<p><i>met by Messrs. Russell Williamson, Roscoe Kirk & Eugene Ward, Inez business leaders.</i></p> <p>Arrive Inez, Kentucky. Greeted by a crowd of 1800; spent 15 minutes greeting the people and shaking hands -- motorcade into town where an additional 1200 people were assembled at Court House - local high school band plays "Hail to the Chief." Motorcade proceeds through town to home of Tom Fletcher. President spends about 30 minutes on the porch with the Fletcher family which was joined by the Bowen family "from down the way." President reviewed with these two families the problems they face in Appalachia. Fletcher is an unemployed lumber mill worker, age 38. Has 8 children, two of whom are school dropouts. Fletcher worked 5 days last month and has a total annual income for his family of \$400. Leaving the porch with Mrs. Johnson, he told Fletcher to "keep your kids in school." Motorcade back to Inez <i>Inez Inez</i> where it was halted by large crowds. The President stopped and shook hands before proceeding to helicopter site.</p>
