				Program then begins to end - benediction given and processional begins. Pres. shakes hands w/ all students leaving by him; he gets very hot from lights & heat inside; so just goes down shaking hands w/ all to sit down more quickly. Press & Cecil Stoughton take pictures of Pres. & classmates - 3 ladies - Much hand-clapping fr. audience. Mrs. J. steps up to podium to say thanks also for the friendship of the people in the Hill Country.
