Other Defense Dept. officials were present. He departed office and went down through a corridor lined with soldiers, sailors and marines and men of the air force to the area where Secy. McNamara presided over ceremony. The President spoke, interrupted his speech for Secy. McNamara to introduce each of the 19 individuals who received the 13 awards for cost reduction, and at this point the President presented each man with his certificate of his contribution to the program and shook hands with the individual. Seated on the platform were the President and Secy. McNamara and Gen. Wheeler. After the awarding of the certificates, the President finished his remarks. Walked down the concourse stairwell into his car escorted by Secy. McNamara, Secy. Vance, and Gen. Wheeler -- bade them goodbye, and departed the Pentagon by car w/ General Clifton. NOTE: In briefing room were Secy. Ailes, Secy. Nitze, Secy. Zuckert, Gen. Wheeler, General Harold Johnson, Admiral McDonald, General LeMay, Lt. Gen Hayes, Dr. Harold Brown, Charles J. Hitch, Joseph A. Califano, Jr., Daniel M. Luevano, Kenneth E. BeLieu, Robert H. Charles, Joseph M. Lyle, Major General L. J. Lincoln, Vice Admiral William A. Schoech, Lt. Gen. Thomas P. Gerrity
