R. 2262 - because approval of this bill would vreate an unfortunate precedent which would weaken the effectiveness of necessary distraint procedures in the collection of revenues due the Government. Today approved the following: H. J. Res. 658, Joint Resolution authorizing and requesting the President to proclaim 1964 and 1965 as a period to "See the United States," and for other purposes. H. R. 11622, An Act to permit the vessel United States ship Alabama to pass through the Panama Canal without payment of tolls.
