As the President's motorcade was led into the gate, a 21 gun salute was fired, and Hail to the Chief was played. As the car pulled up to the front of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, the President was greeted by General Curtis E. LeMay, USAF, Acting Chairman of JCS; Vice Admiral Fitzhugh Lee, Commandant of National War College; Lt. Gen. August Schomburg, USA, Commandant, Industrial College of Armed Forces; other members of the Joint Chiefs, and Secretary of the Army, Cyrus Vance. The President went upstairs for an informal RECEPTION with some faculty members and had a cup of coffee. Then the President went to the Speaker's Stage, escorted by General LeMay, and Admiral Lee and General Schomburg. Secretary Vance introduced the President, and the President read from a typewritten draft. After his REMARKS to the Joint Convocation of the National War College and Industrial College of the Armed Forces, the President walked to his car, said goodbye to the two commandants, and departed Ft. McNair w/ Asst. Secy. of Defense, Arthur Sylvester, and they met in the car en route to the White House. On return to the White House, the President sent Secy. Sylvester to the Pentagon in the President's limousine. While at Ft. McNair, the President asked General Clifton to look for a good house for a Vice President in the area around the military establishment.
