	1:15			Arrive Bergstrom AFB. Deplanes from rear entrance of AF#1 w/ Mrs. Johnson, Senator and Mrs. Humphrey, Senator and Mrs. Yarborough, Cong. and Mrs. J. J. (Jake) Pickle, Governor and Mrs. Connally. Goes immediately to fence, to shake hands w/ Humphrey and Yarborough, stopping at enge of crowd to greet two little girls holding sign "Lyndon likes Little People." Approximately 300 people waiting to view the Presidential Party. Clapped loudly as the President and First La dy deplaned. Mrs. Johnson took Mrs. Humphrey with her and they covered another section of the fence, and the President took Sen. Humphrey with him. This handshaking lasted until 2:40, when they boarded a waiting helicopter for the LBJ Ranch in the company of Senator and Mrs. Hubert Humphrey and their son, Doug, Mrs. Kay (Phil) Graham, Mrs. Johnson, Judge Moursund. -- arrived LBJ Ranch at 2:10..took a little ride in the white electric car to show the Humphreys a quick view of the immediate area surrounding the ranch house.
