Probably 4-5,000 people there. Very enthusiastic crowd greeted the President and First Lady. High School band then played Hello Lyndon. Enthusiastic clapping from the audience. Mr. Arthur Stehling, Dem. Chairman of Gillespie County, welcomed everybody, then a minister with heavy German accent gave blessing, national anthem played. Mr. Stehling invited Mrs. Johnson say a few words, which she did. Sen. and Mrs. Humphrey were introduced. The Senator spoke. Sen. and Mrs. Yarborough were introduced. Senator Yarbrough spoke in German. Cong. Pickle was introduced. President was introduced at 8:05pm, and spoke -- 8:27 stopped speaking. Judge Ferguson spoke briefly afterward. At 8:35, the President stopped the Judge and said that he'd forgot to mention something, and went again to the Speaker's stand and told the people gathered how helpful the Texas Delegation has been to Him at the convention. Benediction. Program closed, descended the platform, and shook hands with all of the people going to the car. Took about 10 minutes to get to the car.</p>
