Met by the pastor, Dr. Townsend. Attended services which lasted until 10:10am. Drove back through the town, stopped at the Pioneer Museum, but the President did not get out of the automobile. Looked at the area briefly. Got back in the car, and continued drive to Ranch. Just before he got to the ranch, he said that it was all right for the Press to follow him on the ranch and he drove in the East Gate and went to his birthplace cabin. Press following. Invited them to come with him to the Cemetery. After that came on up and stopped at the house next to Cousin Oriole and looked at it briefly, then came up and visited with Cousin Oriole in her yard. Came on through the gate into the fields. Still followed by press. Drove around the fields. Then went on toward the foreman's house. Stopped and visited w/ the Malechek family. Press present. Then returned to the House. Press departed -- did not come to the house
