- S. 26, An Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to construct, operate and maintain the Dixie project, Utah, and for other purposes.
- S. 793, An Act to promote the conservation of the Nation's wildlife resources on the Pacific flyway in the Tule Lake, Lower Klamath, Upper Klamath, and Clear Lake National Wildlife Refuges in Oregon and California and to aid in the administration of the Klamath reclamation project.
- H. J. Res. 393, Joint Resolution to authorize the President to proclaim October 9 in each year as Leif Erikson Day.
- H. R. 130, An Act to provide for the payment of compensation, including severance damages, for rights-of-way acquired by the United States in connection with reclamation projects the construction of which commenced after January 1. 1961.
- H. R. 1136, An Act to compensate certain parties for the loss of their leasehold interests in lands taken by the United States in connection with the Red Rock Reservoir project.
- H. R. 1213, An Act for the relief of World Games, Incorporated.
- H. R. 2215, An Act for the relief of E. A. Rolfe, Junior.
- H. R. 3672, An Act to provide for the construction, operation, and maintenance of the Savery-Pot Hook, Bostwick Park, and Fruitland Mesa participating reclamation projects under the Colorado River Storage Project Act.
