				Senate Candidate, Mrs. Grace M. Sloan, Candidate for State Auditor General; Thomas Z. Minehart, Candidate for State Treasurer; Judge J. Sidney Hoffman, Candidate for State Superior Court; Judge Robert Lee Jacobs, Candidate for State Superior Court; Senator Joseph S. Clark, former Governor George M. Leader, former Ambassador John S. Rice (to Netherlands), former Governor David L. Lawrence, Mrs. Louise John, Vice Chairman of State Central Cmtee (who presented flowers to Mrs. Johnson on arrival).	
				Senator Clark, Miss Blatt and former Gov. 's Leader and Lawrence escorted the President through the crowd held back by Pa. State Police. It was an enthusiastic, squealing mob that reached to touch the President as he moved along.	
				THE PRESIDENT SPOKE to assembled group for about 2 minutes - then Mrs. Johnson spoke, with Sen. Clark and Miss Blatt standing right beside.	
	9:03p			The Pres. accompanied by Miss Blatt and members of party departed the helicopter site and motored approximately 250 yards to entrance of Farm Show Building.	
	9:05p			Arrived at a small arena, Farm Show Building - attended President's Club Reception - visited with 105 members of Club. The hall was steaming -- lacking air conditioning and ventilation.	
	9:10p			The President went to a house trailer located outside - and changed his shirt. He was accompanied by Mrs. Johnson, Ken Gaddis, Sen. Joseph Clark and Wilson McCarthy.	
	9:20p			Departed house trailer and entered a hall where approx. 5500 people had finished dinner and were obviously waiting for the President. The President mounted a long, 2-ft high rostrum and head table from the left side and walked to the middle of the rostrum where the speaker's stand was.	
	9:30p			Miss Genevieve Blatt, candidate for U. S. Senate - introduced the President - carried on live TV.	
	9:30p			REMARKS BY THE PRESIDENT to Democratic Fund-Raising Dinner at Pennsylvania Farm Show - concluded @10:00 pm.	
				Note: (the loudest applause came when the President said "that we were a nation of lovers and not haters." -- this was an ad lib remark and was not in prepared text.	Commission.
	10:04p			Departed the head table and walked to the house trailer. ---changed shirt for second time. Took car and was taken approx. 250 yds to Helicopter Site arr'g @10:12.	
	10:14p			Airborne by Helicopter for White House - South Lawn with Mrs. Johnson, Ken O'Donnell, JV, Lt. Col. James Connell, Dr. Burkley, Sgt Gaddis, Wilson McCarthy, Blair Lee, Youngblood & Rivett - USSS.
