				Awakened and had breakfast in bed with Mrs. Johnson --

	10:35			To church w/ Mrs. Johnson, Mr. J. C. Kellam, Mary Rather, JV, vm -- via automobile A caravan of newspaper reporters awaited the exit of the President from the Ranch gates so that they could follow him into town. The party drove down the dirt road past the President's birthplace that is being remodeled and stopped to look at it and discuss the renovation with Mr. Kellam and Mrs. Johnson. He then drove on into the highway (President at the wheel of the car) and was followed by assembled cars of newspaper reporters and photographers all the way into Johnson City. — arriving at 10:55am	
10:55	11:00			Church services at the First Christian Church of Johnson City, Texas with above party.	
11:38	11:40			After services, the President shook hands with the pastor of the church -- Ray Aiken (who is the brother of Harry Aiken of Austin, Tex.) and with several members of the Church. Photogs were gathered outside of the church for pics of the President and First Lady -- they posed for pics and waved, then proceeded to their car.	
11:53	12:00			President decided to go by and visit with the Melvin Winters' at their home just outside of Johnson City. On the way, they passed the family of A. W. Moursund and all joined at the Winters' residence for a cup of coffee. Mrs. Winters' was there and the ladies fixed a pot of coffee for the President, Mrs. Johnson, Judge A. W. Moursund, Mrs. Moursund, Mary Moursund, Will Moursund, Mary Rather, JV, vm -- (Mr. Winters' was at the office) JV checked in with WH operator at Ranch and asked for any troubles or phone calls for President and then reported to the President that Mc George Bundy had called. He then decided that they had better return to the Ranch because -- "Oh, oh.... Mac Bundy is calling and he never has any good news." He asked vm to call WH at ranch to see if her parents and sister, Dunya, had arrived for lunch.... vm reported yes.... and the party departed. Mr. Winters' arrived just as the party was departing and the President and Mrs. Johnson shook hands with him and said that they were sorry that they had to run and would visit with them longer on another trip.... then said goodbye to the Moursund family and Mrs. Winter'

Mrs. Alexander pointed out items of interest to the President and Mrs. Johnson -- original sofa, chairs, etc.... The Alexanders were invited to have lunch at the Ranch but regretted. The party then departed for the Ranch..... the same group of photogs and reporters followed.	
	12:55			Arrived at Ranchhouse and went into the den to greet Mr. and Mrs. J. H. McCammon, and Dunya -- parents and sister of vm. They sat down and visited and had coffee in the living room

	1:20			The President took the McCammons on a tour of the house and gave Mr. McCammon a LBJ Ranch hat. Then he took them on a tour of the ranch and up to the foreman's house -- Dale Malachuk -- to look at the recently trophies won trophies on cattle shows.... asked vm to go but vm said that she couldn't.	
	2:00			Returned to the immediate ranch house and had lunch with Mrs. Johnson, Mr. Kellam, Mary Rather, Mr. and Mrs. J. H. McCammon, Dunya McCammon, JV, vm	
	2:40			To living room for cup of coffee and read papers and visited with the McCammons. Told vm to take car and go driving around with family.	
	3:15			To bedroom to take a little nap	
	3:40			Arose and made preparations to leave -- dep. house in golf cart and bid farewell to Mr. and Mrs. McCammon
