	7:35a				Motorcade to the airport. (During the motorcade, the President sent word back to Secretaries' car to tell them to pull out of the motorcade, stop at the nearest drugstore and purchase a manicure set for him -- his hands were in poor shape from much handshaking, etc. )	
	7:47				Arrived Airport -- and shook hands with the crowd.	
	7:50				Wheels up for RENO, NEVADA -- aboard AF-1, visiting in Cabin w/ Senators Cannon and Bible.	
	8:55				Arrived RENO, NEVADA-- airport -- met by a reception committee, ladies garbed in long red pants and red checked shirts, blue uniformed ladies. Band playing "Hello Lyndon." Sunny weather, 41 degrees.	
					Shook hands with crowd -- approx. 2,000 people (police estimate in all cases today)	
	9:05				Motorcade departed -- President accompanied by Senators <sup>Howard</sup> Cannon and <sup>Alan</sup> Bible for the 2 mile drive. Stopped once on the route at the Democratic headquarters. President stood on running board of car and waved to the group gathered there. Took bullhorn and talked to the crowd. Stopped again, got the bull horn and invited the crowds to come with him to look at a very large sign that said, "Hello, Lyndon, Nevada not Goldwater Country!"	
	9:30				Arrived State Building. Loud cheering and Hail to the Chief as he mounted the platform. Leaned over the platform railing for about 5 minutes to meet with Jack Dempsey. (He invited Mr. Dempsey to come to the next state Dinner and thanked him for all his help thus far.

	10:20				Motorcade begins to move as the President walked part of the way waving to the crowds. Arrived airport at 10:30 am -- no stops.	
	10:40				Wheels up for Butte, Montana. Aboard AF-1 -- asked VM and MF to come into cabin and treat his windburned face and do something about torn and ragged cuticles and fingernails.	
	11:55				Arrived BUTTE, MONTANA airport. Greeted by Senator and Mrs. Mike Mansfield Senator Lee Metcalf, Congr. Olsen, Roland Renne (gubernatorial candidate) Also a line of miners wearing miners' gear. Rode along the fence and shook hands with crowds.	
	12:05p				Motorcade departed airport. Accompanying the President were Senator Mansfield, Senator Metcalf and Butte population is only 46,000, and the police chief estimated that at least 40,000 saw the President on the motorcade route. The day was sunny, temperature were comfortable and this contributor to crowds.	
	12:26				Arrived Civic Center -- the President went to a small room off the platform and waited for the program to move along and for Senator Mansfield to introduce him. He drank a cup of coffee and rested quietly.	
	12:40				The President was introduced by Senator Mansfield. Tumultuous welcome in Civic Center as it held the largest crowd ever to be in the building -- 12,000 people. At the introduction the President acknowledged three minutes of applause and cheering -- and the chant....."All the way with LBJ!"
