SUBJECT: Proposed Trip

The following are flying times for the Queen Air and for the Helicopter:

QUEEN AIR

From LBJ Ranch to Stinson Field - 18 minutes.
From Stinson Field to the Aero Space Medical Center - 10 minutes - automobile.
From Stinson Field to Governor's Ranch - 10 minutes.
From LBJ Ranch to Governor's Ranch - 23 minutes.

HELICOPTER

From LBJ Ranch to Aero Space Medical Center - 30 minutes.
From Aero Space Medical Center to Governor's Ranch - 7 minutes.
From LBJ Ranch to Governor's Ranch - 37 minutes.

NOTE: Brooks AFB is closed to Aircraft traffic. Stinson Field is nearby and would require a vehicular movement from there to the Medical Center. Stinson Field is a low cost housing development besides being an airport for small aircraft.

If it is the President's wish to go from the LBJ Ranch to the Aero Space Medical Center and then to the Governor's Ranch by Queen Air, a total time of 48 minutes would be required, including auto motorcade.

If the President desires to use helicopters for this trip, the total time would be 37 minutes and no auto motorcade would be involved. (Since choppers could land at the Aero Space Medical Center.)
