To delay time, the President visited aboard the aircraft with the press, w/ Valentis and their baby, Lynda; and then deplaned and greeted the small crowd of people waiting. The temperature was in the 50s and the group shivered, but the President and Mrs. Johnson wore no coats. The motorcade departed. Riding w/ the President were Mrs. Johnson, Secy Udall and Sylvia Porter. Again to delay arrival at the Frank Erwin residence, the motorcade drove slowly and took a turn around the campus of the University of Texas. At 7:00 the motorcade arrived at the residence of Frank Erwin, democratic committeeman for the State of Texas. The President and Mrs. Johnson were the first arrivals at the dinner party honoring the Warren Woodwards; however, during the evening, the President visited w/ other guests including Governor and Mrs. John Connally, Mr. and Mrs Bill Heath, Mr. and Mrs. Ed Clark, Mr. and Mrs. Jim Wilson, Mr. and Mrs. Ed Rowe, Mr. and Mrs. Tom Miller, Jr., mr. and Mrs. Tom McCrummin,
