	6:37	6:46			The Party departed the LBJ Ranch enroute to the West Ranch (Wesley West) via helicopter. They were met by Judge A. W. Moursund who joined the hunting party. In the car w/ the President were Governor Sanders, Judge A. W. Moursund, Senator Herman Talmadge, and all departed for the Nicholson Ranch -- where they went in and the President showed them various pics that were hung around the Ranch house. They also ate some cheese in the Ranch House.
