	5:50	5:55	Remarks		On completion, he turned around and asked Secy Zuckert to read General Powers' citation. The President then pinned the medal on Powers. Powers responded with brief remarks. The President and Mrs. Johnson stepped back from the podium and greeted Mrs. Powers. They then shook hands w/ the Joint Chiefs of Staff who were present -- all except LeMay -- and posed for pictures w/ General and Mrs. Powers. When the President departed, Mrs. Johnson stayed and greeted the guests.
