On arrival at the Armory, the party went into Dutch Bergman's office (manager of the Armory). Mrs. Johnson, the girls and their dates were chatting gaily while the President sat in an overstuffed chair and took a nap while waiting. VP-elect and Mrs. Humphrey joined the Presidential Party in the office just prior to their 11:57 12:30a Retired making appearance on the Gala in the Presidential box. "Hail to the Chief" was played, many pictures taken, lights were dimmed, and the Gala began.
