NOMINATIONS SENT TO THE SENATE ON JANUARY 27, 1965:

Rear Admiral Robert B. Brown, Medical Corps, U. S. Navy, for appointment as Chief of the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery in the Department of the Navy for a term of four years.

Vice Admiral William A. Schoech, U. S. Navy, for appointment to the grade of vice admiral, when retired, pursuant to the provisions of Title 10, United States Code, Section 5233.

Having designated, under the provisions of Title 10, United States Code, Section 5231, Rear Admiral Ignatius J. Galantin, U. S. Navy, for commands and other duties determined by the President to be within the contemplation of said section, for appointment to the grade of vice admiral while so serving.

Lieutenant General Thomas Weldon Dunn, 018517, Army of the United States (major general, United States Army), for appointment as Senior United States Army Member of the Military Staff Committee of the United Nations, under the provisions of Title 10, United States Code, section 711.

The following-named officers under the provisions of Title 10, United States Code, section 3066, to be assigned to a position of importance and responsibility designated by the President under subsection (a) of section 3066, in grades as follows:

Major General Edgar Collins Doleman, 019131, United States Army, in the grade of Lieutenant General.

Lieutenant General Robert William Porter, Junior, 018048, Army of the United States (major general, United States Army), in the grade of General.
