	1:20 p				Helicopter from South Lawn to Andrews AFB arriving at 1:30p accompanied by Mrs. Johnson, Bess Abell, Marvin Watson, MF Commander Josephson, Dr. Burkley, Rufus Youngblood, Jerry Kivett, and Ken Gaddis	
C	1:30p				To Lexington, Kentucky via jetstar w/ above in addition to Congressman John C. Watts. The President -- even before takeoff -- seated himself on the couch, informed all passengers that he would be resting, and was covered with a blanket and had his eyes closed before the plane took off.	
	2:40p				Arrived Blue Grass Airport - Lexington, Kentucky. The President and Mrs. Johnson were met by: C Governor and Mrs. Edward T. Breathitt C Mayor and Mrs. Fred Fugazzi (Lexington) Judge and Mrs. Bart Peak. A small crowd was at the airport, and the advance man, Marty Underwood, reported that this was so because most of the crowd had gathered at the coliseum, and it was not expected to have an airport welcome for the President.	
	2:45p				Motorcade departed the airport. Riding with the President were Mrs. Johnson, Governor Breathitt, Mayor <del>and</del> Fugazzi, Judge Peak and Congressman Watts.	
	3:00p				Arrived the University of Kentucky campus at the Memorial Coliseum. The President was greeted by the President of the University, John W. Oswald and walked through a cordon of ROTC members into the coliseum and directly to the "K" room where he robed and then proceeded into the coliseum proper. The President wasted no time, and with the help of Ken Gaddis and President Oswald he robed -- he did wear a robe belonging to the University of Kentucky -- not his own -- because the University officials wanted the robe worn by the President at the conferring of the degree to go into their library.
