					Just as the party was seated in the pew, the choir filed into the box and the service began. No advance notice had been given the Pastor of the Church, G. Bartow Harris. At one one point, Rev. Harris walked to the agent sitting in the pew across from the President and asked, "Is that really the President?" The agent replied replied in the affirmative and Rev Harris then asked him if he thought it appropriate for him to offer a prayer for the President at the end of the service. He The agent again ssid, "Yes," and suggested that Rev Harris escort the President and Mrs. Johnson from their pew to the cars outside the church -- which he did.	
					Outside the church a crowd had gathered -- approximately 500 - - and the President shook hands with many of the people there.	
					En route to Camp David he stopped his car outside a Catholic Church to shake hands with two priests and ten nuns who were standing along the route.
