					The weather on this morning -- was very cloudy and overcast -- and it was decided that the Presidential <del>would</del> party would have to drive in to Austin to board AF-1.	
					The President loaded up everyone and drove past Hye, Texas. In the car w/ him were: Vice Admiral Raborn (Wm. Francis, Jr.), Mr. Richard Helms, Senator McCarthy. At that point, he decided that it would be all right, to return to the Ranch ;and board the choppers for flight into Bergstrom AFB, Austin, Texas.
