THE PRESIDENT HAS APPROVED THE FOLLOWING:

May 15, 1965

S. 60, An Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to designate the Nez Perce National Historical Park in the State of Idaho, and for other purposes.

H. R. 5702, An Act to extend for one year the date on which the National Commission on Food Marketing shall make a final report to the President and to the Congress and to provide necessary authorization of appropriations for such Commission.
