THE PRESIDENT HAS APPROVED THE FOLLOWING:

May 22, 1965

- S. 701, An Act to carry out the obligations of the United States under the International Coffee Agreement, 1962, signed at New York on September 28, 1962, and for ~~other~~ purposes.
- H. R. 66, An Act to authorize the Board of Parole of the District of Columbia to discharge a parolee from supervision prior to the expiration of the maximum term or terms for which he was sentenced.
- H.R. 3043, An Act to amend title 37, United States Code, to authorize payment of special allowances to dependents of members of the uniformed services to offset expenses incident to their evacuation, and for other purposes.
- H.R. 4338, An Act to authorize the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States to rent certain property in the District of Columbia for certain office purposes.
- H. J. Res. 195, Joint Resolution to authorize the Commissioners of the District of Columbia to promulgate special regulations for the period of the American Legion National Convention of 1966, to be held in Washington, District of Columbia; to authorize the granting of certain permits to The American Legion 1966 Convention Corporation of the District of Columbia on the occasion of such convention, and for other purposes.
