					In the Governor's offices, the President met w/ and visited w/ the donors of the portrait and various friends, and Senators. Among those there, were Mr. Harry J. ersig, Judge and Mrs. Homer Thornberry Senator Dorsey Hardeman, , etc.	
	10:06				Departed the State Capitol and moved to the waiting car -- Municipal Auditorium	
	10:09				Arrived at the heloport/and boarded helos w/ Judge and Mrs. Homer Thornberry, Sen. Murray Watson, Jake Jacobsen and VM (JV in #2 chopper) The group flew to James Connally AFB, Waco, Texas -- and encountered severe weather conditions along the way -- rain and wind.	
	11:06				Arrived at James Connally AFB, Waco, Texas -- w/ party - and entered auto for motorcade to Heart O'Texas Coliseum in Waco arriving at 11:34 am. The President moved to an anteroom in the rear of the coliseum and donned his cap and gown for commencement activities of Baylor University. Also -- the teleprompter script did not arrive at all -- since it was on the press plane) The gprogram had begun -- and the President moved forward to be introduced and accept.
