R. Ben Hosler, of Ohio, to be United States Marshal for the Northern District of Ohio for the term of four years. (Reappointment)

Fred F. Hoh, of Ohio, to be United States Marshal for the Southern District of Ohio for the term of four years. (Reappointment)

Ellis Maylett, of Utah, to be United States Marshal for the District of Utah for the term of four years. (Reappointment)
