	7:25				The reporters were called in as were the photogs to take pics of the Presidents in the living room of the President's suite. Both President Johnson and President Truman answered a few questions and talked w/ the reporters for a very short while. (Jake Jacobsen was also in the room -- and President Truman said to him ---- "Jacobsen -- that's a good name -- that was the name of my partner"	
	7:45				The Presidential party departed the Muehlbach Hotel -- and the President walked around to the people that were roped off to bid him farewell and shook hands w/ them... then to the motorcade for trip to airport w/ President Harry Truman. Senators ✓ Frank Church and Frank Carlson (R)

	10:40				The Presidential motorcade departed the San Francisco International Airport, Coast Guard station, and proceeded to the Opera House in proper San Francisco. In the car w/ the President were Amb. Hand, Lynda, Cong. Phil Burton, and Cyril Magnin representing Gov. Brown and Mayor John Shelly of SF.	
	11:05	am			Arrived at the Opera House and was greeted by Hon. Adlai Stevenson, U. S. Rep. to the United Nations, Governor and Mrs. Edmund Brown, Mayor and Mrs. John Shelly. The President posed in front of the Opera House w/ the group for pics, then proceeded to an anteroom in the Opera House to freshen up.

Lynda Bird was also in the meeting, but the President said that "she just sat in a corner and read her book. ! "	
2:20					Emergded from the RanxXxxxxx Opera House and moved to his limousine w/ Lynda	
					Departed the Opera House and motored to San Francisco International Airport in motorcade procession -- to the private Coast Guard section of the terminal.	
					The President kissed Lynda Bird -- and photogs snapped pics.... then the President boarded the plane for flight to Texas	
4:53					Airborne from San Francisco, California enroute to Bergstrom AFB arriving at 7:38 PST	
5:38					Upon arrival at Bergstrom AFB, the President boarded a helicopter and flew to the Haywood Ranch arriving at 6:11 pm -- and immediately went to the boats.	
6:16	9:15				Boating on Lake Lyndon B. Johnson	
10:28					Departed the Haywood Ranch and returned to the LBJ Ranch arriving at 10:50 pm went to the Main House and retired for the evening.
