THE PRESIDENT TODAY APPROVED THE FOLLOWING:

- S. J. Res. 83, Joint Resolution to authorize the President to issue a proclamation commemorating the one hundred and seventy-fifth anniversary, on August 4, 1965, of the founding of the United States Coast Guard at Newburyport, Massachusetts.
- H. R. 70, An Act to provide for the conveyance of approximately 80 acres of land to the heirs of Adam Jones, Creek Indian not enrolled.
- H. R. 1987, An Act for the relief of Nabhane M. Nickley (Nabhane M. Karam).
- H. R. 2012, An Act for the relief of Doctor Ignace D. Liu.
- H. R. 2499, An Act for the relief of Remedios Ocampo.
- H. R. 4131, An Act for the relief of Mrs. Phoebe Thompson Neesham.
- H. R. 8862, An Act to amend the Act of August 7, 1935, to increase the authorized annual share of the United States as an adhering member of the International Council of Scientific Unions and Associated Unions.
- H. R. 9041, An Act to restore to the heirs of the Indian grantor certain tribal land of the Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma.
